Keilani Bolhuis, 17, is the current Roman Andrew Borek scholarship recipient, and has been studying at the Pasadena Conservatory of Music since 2012. She began learning piano with Nadia Cherni in Burbank when she was six years old. At PCM, her early music studies in Suzuki violin were with Madeleine Eaton and Tami Iskenderian, and her music theory teacher was Katherine Eames. In 2016, she began studying jazz piano with Khris Kempis. Then in 2017 at PCM, she began studying violin with Elizabeth Hedman. At PCM, she also studies jazz piano with Amy Rowe, jazz violin with Megan Shung, and participates in Jazz Combo with Danny Janklow. Keilani was one of 16 Jazz Instrumental Semi-Finalists in the Music Center's Spotlight competition in 2023, and she won the branch and regional levels of the Southern California Junior Bach Festival in piano performance. Keilani was awarded the National Gold Medal by the Royal Conservatory of Music and invited to perform at the Celebration of Excellence Ceremony at Carnegie Hall in January of last year. She also has led The Goat Kids student band that performs at PCM's Goat Concert receptions. Keilani is currently pursuing her interest in music arranging and composing. Keilani is a graduating senior at California School of the Arts - San Gabriel Valley, where she is the Concertmaster of both the Symphonia Orchestra and Philharmonic Orchestra. She has just been accepted to the New England Conservatory of Music's Contemporary Musical Arts program and is excited to start in the fall!
